- The Board President will establish a work group made up of four BESE members, to include a work group chair, which shall serve as the nominating and screening committee regarding the minimum qualifications and process relevant to the appointment of the State Superintendent. The President will appoint the members of the work group and notify the BESE Executive Director of the membership no later than January 27, 2020.
- The work group will meet to develop a process for the selection of an appointment of the State Superintendent. The process for selection will be presented to the Board for review at the January 28, 2020, BESE meeting.
